After spending a few years building his first two bikes at a friend's shop in Middletown, PA, Greg Carter decided to open his own shop in Lewisberry in 1999. Building up his clientele he expanded on his shop and hired full- and part-time employees. In 2000 he incorporated and filed for trademarks taking his business to the next level. In 2005 he made the decision to move the shop to Lemoyne, PA, and took on Scott Fisher as his partner to help with the growing list of clientele and bike builds from day to day.

Greg Carter has been featured in many national publications such as American Iron, Hot Bagger, American Bagger and Sturgis Rider Magazine. He won the Metzeler Cup in 2007 in Sturgis and traveled throughout Europe and the U.S. promoting the shop and Metzeler Tires. All of his accomplishments came from hard work and with Co-Owner & Vice President Scott Fisher by his side.

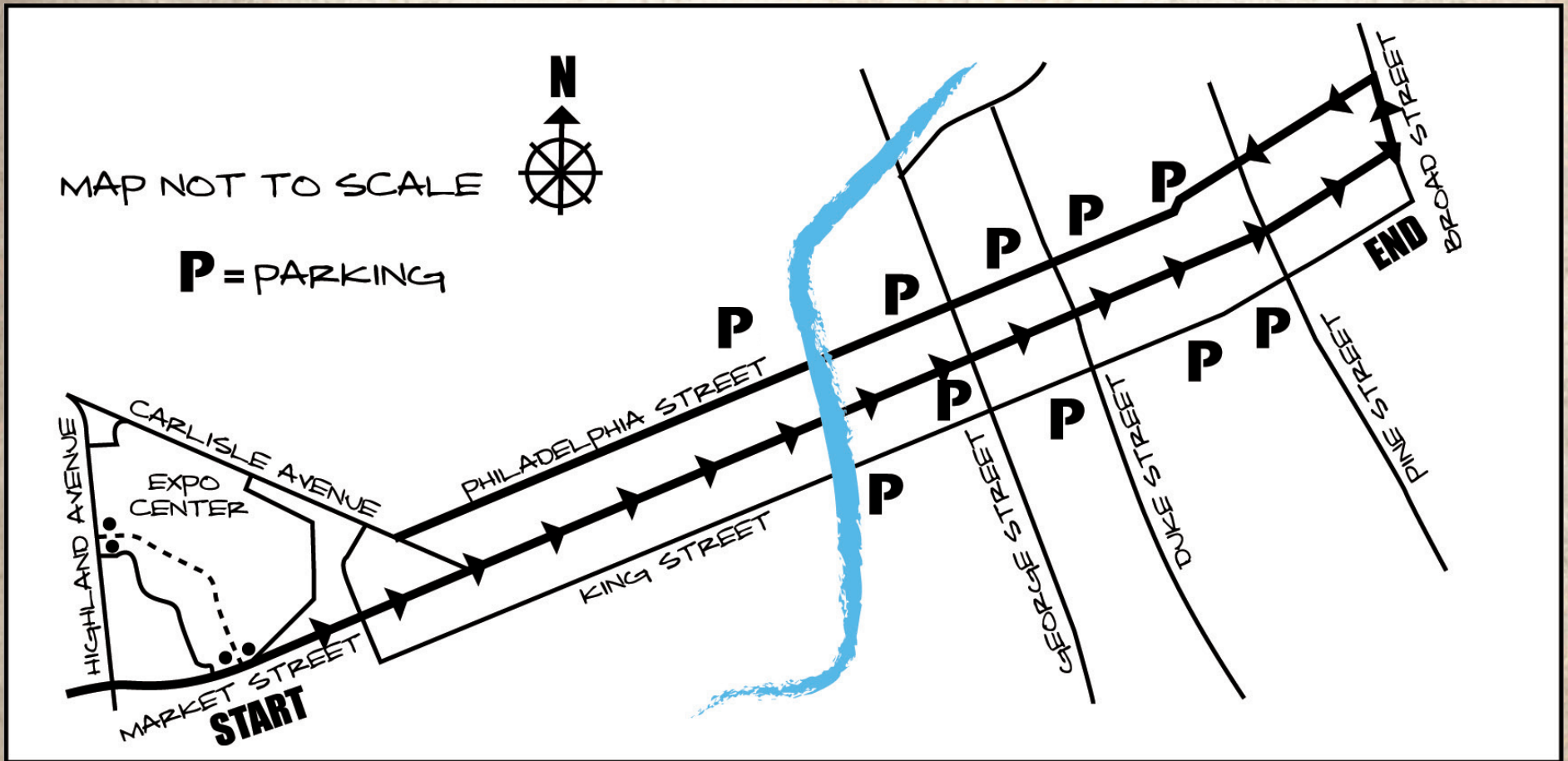
