I. Call Public Hearing to order at 10:00 a.m.

City Council has called this public hearing to order for the purpose of receiving testimony concerning the application filed with the PA Liquor Control Board by Vintage Companies, LLC, trading as Vintage Wine Bar, for an economic development liquor license for the purpose of establishing a wine bar/restaurant at 2 W. Market St., York, PA. ([Read info sheet](#))

An economic development liquor license is a restaurant or eating place retail dispenser license which may be issued, even if the number of existing restaurant and eating place retail dispenser licenses in said county exceeds the ratio of one (1) license per 3,000 inhabitants. The purpose of an economic development license is to promote economic development; however, the city is limited to issuing no more than two such licenses each calendar year.

If Council is satisfied with evidence presented after today's public hearing, a vote on this request will be taken during Council's regular legislative meeting scheduled for tonight at 7:00 p.m. here in Council Chambers. If Council is not satisfied with evidence presented today, the vote on this request will be postponed and a special meeting (to occur on or before August 12th) will be convened for the purpose of approving or denying the request.

Council will take into consideration all evidence and testimony received to help determine whether issuance of such a license would promote economic development in the City of York or will adversely affect the welfare, health, peace and morals of the city or its residents.

Please be mindful that this is a public hearing and not a debate session and is to serve as a means to receive evidence and testimony on the request presented.
