WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania State University submitted a Final Land Development Plan for the Penn State York – Ruhl Student Center at 1031 Edgecomb Avenue, proposing installation of an underground stormwater detention system within City limits for the Student Center, which lies in Spring Garden Township; and

WHEREAS, the City Zoning Officer, City Planner, and City Engineer have reviewed and recommended conditional approval of the plan; and

WHEREAS, the Final Land Development Plan submitted by the applicant is in general accordance with the City’s Zoning and Subdivision and Land Development Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the York City Planning Commission recommended conditional approval of the Final Land Development Plan at its regularly scheduled meeting held on September 14, 2015 with the following waivers and contingency items:
