WHEREAS, by passage of Bill No. _____, Ordinance No. _____ of Session 2016, City Council approved an amendment to Article 753 “Streets and Sidewalks” of the York City Codified Ordinances requiring a permit for the closure of streets and sidewalks for construction and rehabilitation activities, and

WHEREAS, Article 753.05(b) states; An applicant for a Sidewalk Closure Permit shall complete an application provided by the Bureau of Permits, Planning and Zoning and pay such fee as is established from time to time by resolution of Council;” and

WHEREAS, Article 753.05(f) states; A Sidewalk Closure Permit shall not be issued for a period exceeding ninety (90) days. The permittee may, with thirty (30) days prior notice, be granted an additional ninety (90) day extension upon payment of such fee as is established from time to time by resolution of Council. Such extension shall be approved by the Traffic Safety Committee, the Director of Public Works, the Police Chief and Fire Chief.”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of York, Pennsylvania, hereby approves sidewalk closure permit fees as follows:

Initial ninety (90) day Sidewalk Closure Permit fee:	\$50.00
Ninety (90) day Sidewalk Closure Permit Renewal fee:	\$100.00

Said fees shall become effective immediately upon approval.
