PROCLAMATION

NATIONAL CRIME PREVENTION MONTH OCTOBER 2011

WHEREAS: The vitality of our city depends on how safe we keep our homes, neighborhoods, schools, workplaces, and community; and

WHEREAS: Crime threatens a community's health, prosperity and quality of life; and

WHEREAS: People of all ages must be made aware of the dangers of crime and how they can protect themselves from becoming victims: and

WHEREAS: The personal injury, financial loss and community deterioration resulting from crime are intolerable and require investment from the entire community; and

WHEREAS: Crime prevention initiatives must promote collaborative efforts to make neighborhoods safer for all ages and to develop positive opportunities for young people; and

WHEREAS: Adults must invest time, resources, and support effective prevention and intervention strategies for youth, and adults must ensure that teens are engaged in programs to drive crime from their communities; and

WHEREAS: Effective crime prevention programs succeed because of partnerships with law enforcement, government agencies, civic groups, schools, faith communities, businesses, and individuals as they help to nurture communal responsibility and instill pride.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, C. KIM BRACEY, Mayor of the City of York do hereby proclaim, October 2011 as
