# **January**

### **Case 1:**

Complainant contacted office because she believes her child (minor) was discriminated against because of her Age (16). Specifically, the minor child was dismissed from her employment after she called off work due to the bad weather. The Complainants' minor child had no previous write ups and that incident was her first time calling off. The Complainant claims the Respondent treats all the minor employees unfairly. Referred to PHRC.

#### Case 2:

Complainant contacted office because she has not received her paycheck on time since she began working for the Respondent in October 2013. The Complainant claims she receives her paycheck two weeks after the pay date. She also claims she is also not receiving compensation for mileage traveled during company time in her personal vehicle. Referred to Department of Labor-Wage and Hour Division.

#### Case 3:

Complainant contacted office because she believes she is being discriminated against due to her Race, African American. Specifically, the Complainant reported to management the racial comments she heard clients say about her; management told her to ignore them and continue working. A short time later, the Complainant was fired for "low clientele retention" and was not given a warning or opportunity to address the issue. Referred to PHRC.
