Complainant contacted the office because she believes she was discriminated against for her disability- anxiety. Specifically, the Complainant accepted a job with the Respondent under the assumption that she did not have to operate heavy machinery. After training, the Complainant was scheduled to operate heavy machinery and informed her Supervisor that she was unable to do so. The Supervisor told he did not want to hear excuses, her she either operates the machine or go home with a point against her record. The following day she was contacted and told not to return to the job site. Referred to PHRC for lack of jurisdiction. Business is located outside of city limits.
