Non-Jurisdictional Briefs

Selected complaints not docketed by the City of York Human Relations Commission referred to Pa Human Relations Commission or other appropriate agency. (Only contains the allegations of the person who called)

<u>Case 1</u>: Complainant contacted office because she believes she was discriminated against because of her Familial Status. Specifically, the Respondent informed the Complainant that she was not to have guests at her home. The Respondent informed the Complainant that if her children were outside, it would be a lease violation. Location outside of city limits, referred to PHRC.

Case 2: Complainant contacted office because he believes he was discriminated against because of Retaliation. Specifically, the Complainant reported a female co-worker to the Human Resources Department for Sexual Harassment after he received nude photos from the co-worker. Shortly after he made the report, he was given a strict schedule and was closely watched by his Supervisor. Location outside of city limits, referred to PHRC.

Case 3: Complainant contacted office because he believes he was discriminated against because of his National Origin-Hispanic. Specifically, the Complainant asked his Supervisor why he had more duties than his co-worker- Caucasian, both were hired the same day and had similar work experience. The Respondent told him it would be taken care of; the Complainant was fired the next day. Location outside of city limits, referred to PHRC.
