October

Case 1:

Complainant contacted office because she believes he was discriminated against because of her national origin-Hispanic. Specifically, the Complainant was hired by Respondent and was required to take exams during training period. During one of the exams, Complainant repeated the questions to herself in Spanish before answering them. At the end of the exam she met with the Supervisor and was told she was terminated from the training because she was speaking another language, which was considered cheating. Location and subject matter outside of city limits, referred to PHRC.

Case 2:

Complainant contacted office because she believes he was discriminated against because of her race- African American. Specifically, the Complainant was terminated from employment after receiving an occurrence on her attendance record. The Complainant states that other non- African American co-workers that also had attendance occurrences on their records were not terminated.
