ENTRY FEE: \$390 which includes one and ½ dozen softballs per team **Plus \$25 cash or separate check made out to ASA of Pennsylvania (this must accompany registration form and League Entry fee)** and \$10.00 additional fee due for each non-city resident on roster. USSSA (no fee)

Registration Deadline – Monday, August 22, 2016, 4:30 p.m. **or the first 24 teams.**

ONLY THE FIRST 24 TEAMS WILL BE ACCEPTED. WE WILL NOT ACCEPT MORE THAN TWENTY-FOUR TEAMS

Reminder Team registration and roster forms must be completed in full at the time of registration. The entry fee must be submitted at this time. (Teams **may not** reserve spot over the phone.) **Completed rosters and all fees must be turned in at the same time that the registration form is submitted. Deadline is Monday, August 22, or first 24 teams.** Teams will NOT be accepted unless ALL information and fees are turned in AT THE SAME TIME.

For the 2016 season the league will be set up into three divisions. All games will be played on Tuesday and Thursday evenings. **MAKE UP GAMES:** Will be rescheduled for Mondays and Wednesdays. Games will be played at the same time and on the same field. On the team registration form teams may request what division they would like to play in. However, no team is guaranteed which division they will play in.

The By-Laws from the Coors Light White Rose Softball League will be used with amendments.

The starting date for the league is Tuesday, September 13, 2016.

A League meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, Aug 30, 2016, 6:15 P.M. at the Voni Grimes Gym, 125 E. College Avenue. Schedules and by-laws will be passed out at this meeting.

The top four (4) teams in each division will make the play-offs.

The Play-offs will be held on the week following the regular season.

Regular scheduled games will always be played on Tuesdays and Thursdays with makeup games always being played on Mondays and Wednesdays

ARTICLE IV

SECTION 3 – Rosters must be turned in with registration form. After August 30, 2016, teams may add two (2) players to their roster. The deadline for registration of these two (2) players is Thursday, September 22, 2016.

ARTICLE VI

Teams will accept the responsibility of playing all games as scheduled. Starting times will be 6:00 p.m., 7:00 p.m., 8:00 p.m., and 9:00 p.m. Teams must be available for all game times and all nights of play (Tuesdays, Thursdays for regular scheduled games and Mondays and Wednesdays for Make up games).

* NO JEWELRY MAY BE WORN ON PLAYING FIELD (EXCEPT WEDDING BANDS AND MEDICAL BRACELETS).

* FULL NAMES MUST BE USED ON THE LINE-UP CARDS.

* PITCHERS ARE ALLOWED THREE (3) PITCHES BETWEEN INNINGS.

* BATTERS ONLY HAVE TEN (10) SECONDS TO "BATTER UP"

*Home Run Rule. All Divisions – One (1) over the fence home run per inning. Any over the fence home runs after the limit will be an out.

* Batters start with a 1-1 count with no courtesy foul ball.
